Bottega Cantina dei Poeti Gold Prosecco Brut, Veneto D.O.C., Italy **HK\$165**

Glera

Fruity, flowery, scents of golden apple and exotic fruit. Fragrant, fresh, dry and well balanced. Fresh exotic fruit aftertaste.

"R" de Ruinart Brut, Reims, France NV **HK\$185**

Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier, Chardonnay

Rich and earthy with complex pear, toast and honeyed flavors that taste mature, picking up caramel and earth flavors that offer uncommon depth and richness.

Laurent-Perrier Brut, Montagne de Reims, France NV **HK\$190**

Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier

Mellowness, finesse and freshness combine to achieve a remarkable balance, in a succession of constantly shifting taste sensations and a long, satisfying finish.

Paul Bara Cuvée Réserve Brut, Bouzy Grand Cru, France NV **HK\$205**

Pinot Noir, Chardonnay,

Combines fruitiness and freshness with great success to produce a full-bodied wine calling to mind juicy fruit, with a touch of pepper.

Bollinger Brut Rosé, Aÿ Grand Cru, France NV **HK\$225**

Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier

Black cherry, grilled plum, pastry, graphite and almond cream in this vibrant rosé, which offers mouthwatering acidity and finely detailed texture.

Vanilla brioche aromas and hints citrus on the finish with a palate that is powerful and rich. Citrus aromas accentuate a fresh and vivacious style. The body is reinforced by captivating hints of brioche and buttered bread.

Pinot Noir

Bright, fresh and intense with notes of raspberries, strawberries and black cherries. The first impression on the palate is that of fresh fruit, followed by a full-bodied yet elegant mouth feel.

Pinot Noir, Chardonnay

The envelope slides and stretches, and the wine becomes more complex and edgy, silkier than it is creamy.

Krug Grande Cuvée Brut, Reims, France NV **HK\$610**

Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier, Chardonnay

A bouquet wonderfully creamy, leading to a magical combination of richness and balance. The long finish is both nutty and toasty, always ending with a final flourish of freshness.

Sémillon, Sauvignon Blanc

Moderate fruit intensity with light honeyed, apricot-tinged fruit. It has decent acidity but it lacks weight and complexity on the finish, feels clipped.

Disznókő Aszú 5 Puttonyos, Tokaji, Hungary 2006 **HK\$180**

Furmint, Zeta, Harslevelu

This is a rich sweetie, with electric acidity backing the dense flavors of dried apricot puree, golden raisin and light passion fruit custard, as the finish stretches out with layered notes of spice, candied citrus and mineral.

Frescobaldi Castello di Pomino Vinsanto, Pomino D.O.C., Tuscany, Italy 2006 **HK\$185**

Trebbiano, Malvasia Toscana and San Colombano

It is smooth and fresh, with notes of toasted almonds and hazelnuts. The finish denotes a sweet component - excellent persistence.

Markus Molitor Beerenauslese, Mosel-Saar-Ruwer, Germany 2006 **HK\$295**

Riesling

The pear and peach notes have a distinctive juicelike character in this round, fleshy Riesling.

Inniskillin Gold Oak-aged Icewine, VQA Niagara Peninsula, Canada 2011 **HK\$370**

Vidal Blanc

The peaches and apricot aromas and flavours develop into complexities of marmalade and candied brown sugar as it ages.

The ample natural acidity is softened by the oak aging adding a creamy vanilla flavor.

Sémillon, Sauvignon Blanc

Cooked apple, with hints of honey, lemon and butter. Turns to dried apricots. Full and round, very sweet, with a candied character. Good enough, but a little cloying on the palate.
