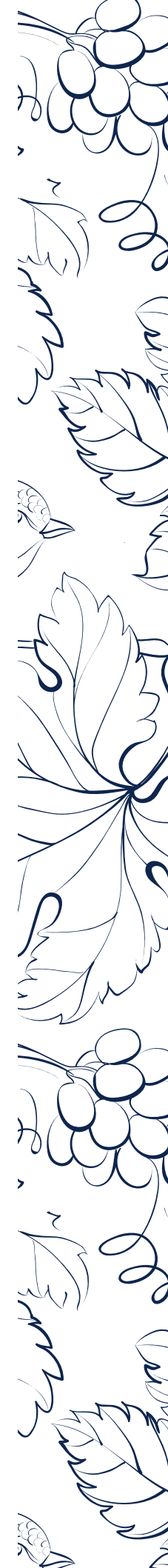


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CHAMPAGNE

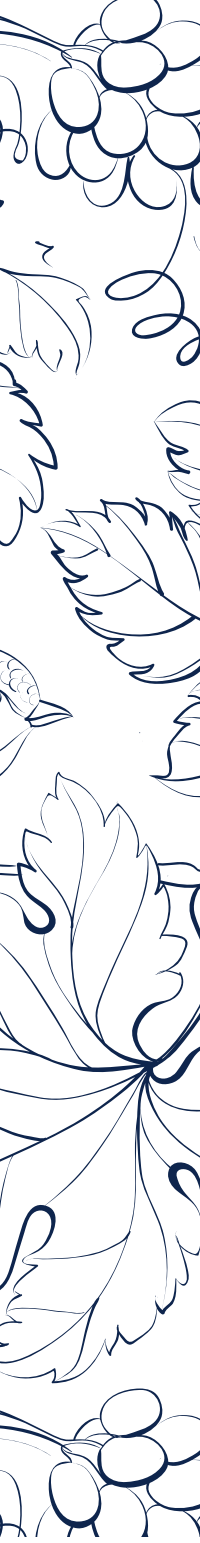
LOIRE VALLEY

BURGUNDY

White Burgundy is just Chardonnay, but the region is also the origin place of the variety, which is by the way, the world's most popular white grape. In Burgundy, the combination of climate, land, and tradition produce a wine that is coveted by many and never precisely replicated anywhere else. Wines from Chablis are frequently described as having citrus and white flower aromas with dry, lean, light-bodied flavors of citrus, pear, minerality and salinity.

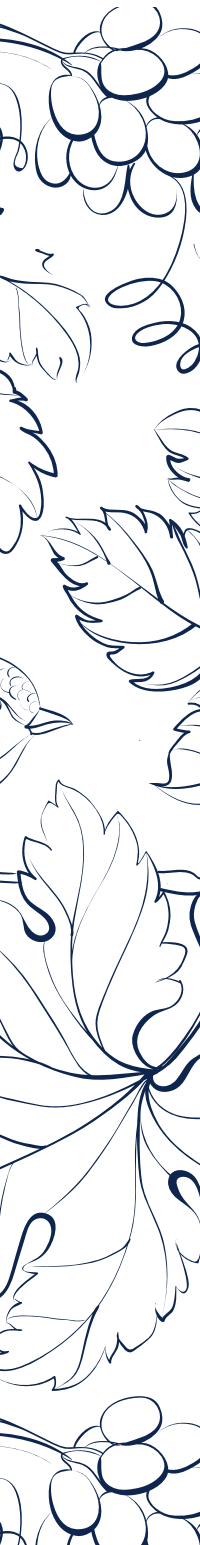

FRANCE

LOIRE VALLEY

This region enjoys a maritime or oceanic climate. Most of the vineyards planted on slopes running east-west benefit from ample sunshine. In this area, very few new oak barrels are used, emphasizing the fresh character of the grapes. The nose flavour mostly bring out dark berry and fruit notes with mild spice and herbal qualities and the palate would be light to medium bodied with red and black berry flavors, moderate acidity and tannins.

RHÔNE VALLEY

It's generally divided into two sub-regions with distinct vinicultural traditions, the Northern Rhône and the Southern Rhône. The northern sub-region produces red wines from the Syrah grape, sometimes blended with white wine grapes. The southern sub-region produces an array of red, white and rosé wines, often blends of several grapes such as in Châteauneuf-du-Pape.

BORDEAUX

Bordeaux reds are medium to full bodied with bold aromas of black currant, plums and an earthiness like smelling wet soil or pencil lead. Depending on the quality, vintage and what region within Bordeaux the wine is from, fruit flavors range from more tart fruit to sweeter ripe fruit. When you taste the wines, they burst with mineral and fruit notes that lead into prickly, savory, mouth-drying tannins. The tannins are often high enough that wines will age for several decades.
